IS IT DONE YET !

Mom's Cornbread (serves 9)

¼ cup butter (softened)
 1 egg
 ½ cup sugar
 ½ teaspoon salt
 1½ cup flour
 2 teaspoons baking powder
 1 cup corn meal
 1 cup milk

1. Start 31 charcoal briquettes in a charcoal chimney and let them burn until all turn gray.
2. In a large bowl, mix butter, egg, and sugar. Alternately add milk and flour, then add all other ingredients and mix thoroughly.
3. Pour batter into a greased 12-inch Dutch oven with lipped lid. Evenly arrange 10 coals on the bottom, set Dutch oven over them, and place 21 coals on the lid.
4. Let bake for 10 minutes and remove two of the coals from the lid and set aside.
5. Bake with remaining coals for another 20 minutes. When inserted toothpick comes out clean, cornbread is ready.

Taco Pie (8 Servings)

1 ½ - 2 lb ground beef
 4 large corn tortillas
 1 can (8 oz) tomato sauce
 1 medium jar taco sauce
 1 small onion diced
 8 oz grated cheddar cheese

Sauté onions until clear; add ground beef, brown until done, remove from heat and drain. Combine tomato and taco sauce. Line Dutch oven with foil. Place 2 tortilla shells in Dutch oven. Place ½ of the beef on top and cover with ½ sauce and sprinkle with cheese. Place 2 more tortilla shells on top and cover with remaining meat and sauce. Sprinkle with remaining cheese. Cover and bake until cheese is melted.

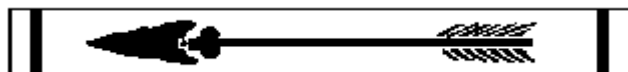
